## Company Profile

- History** The history of GMC Contract & Mobili goes all the way back to the Gera D'Adda region in 1936, when Giovanni Monzio Compagnoni - the grandfather of the current Managing Director of this famous company in Treviso - became fascinated with the techniques of wood carving, characteristic of the low Bergamasco region,
- Evolution** and decided to become a furniture-maker. The initial production of this new enterprise was appreciated by a clientele who still favoured the seventeenth century style, the classic contours of Louis XV and Louis XVI. Success was immediate and continued until the beginning of the seventies, when the company moved to the current premises, which was better suited to the demands of modern furniture-making. The wise acquisition of modern machinery, a technical studio, designed for research into manufacturing processes and materials resulting in efficient craftsmanship and beautiful classic furniture, are only two of the innovations which, from 1975, allowed GMC Contract & Mobili to produce made to measure furniture and to win a stake in a particularly demanding export market. This process was realized thanks
- Marketplaces** to the entrepreneurial initiative of Comm. Adriano Monzio Compagnoni, father of the current Managing Director. Indeed, in 1979, Saudi Arabia became one of GMC Contract & Mobili's major customers. From that date this company from Treviso has developed villas, palaces and apartments for Saudi Arabia's most important figures; prestigious achievements which generated contracts in Kuwait, Oman and Bahrein and which displayed flexibility of technique and design, inspiration and sensitivity to the demands of a sophisticated clientele.
- From 1990 GMC Contract & Mobili quickly expanded into Japan (signing the projects for the Nagae Tower in Chiba, the Aichi New Building and the Tomioka Country Club in Tokyo), while at the same time, expanding in Italy and Europe. It was its developments in the Italian and European hotel industry that confirmed the dynamism of this company, which was increasingly developing "contracts" (a word which was added to its original name at the end of the eighties, when it became GMC Contract & Mobili), increasingly "serving" an idea and transforming it and making it possible. A principle which has always been at the heart of GMC Contract & Mobili's philosophy is the firm desire to create stable structures inside markets, by collaborating with world famous architects and designers. This entrepreneurial vision is also confirmed in the most recent public and private contracts.
